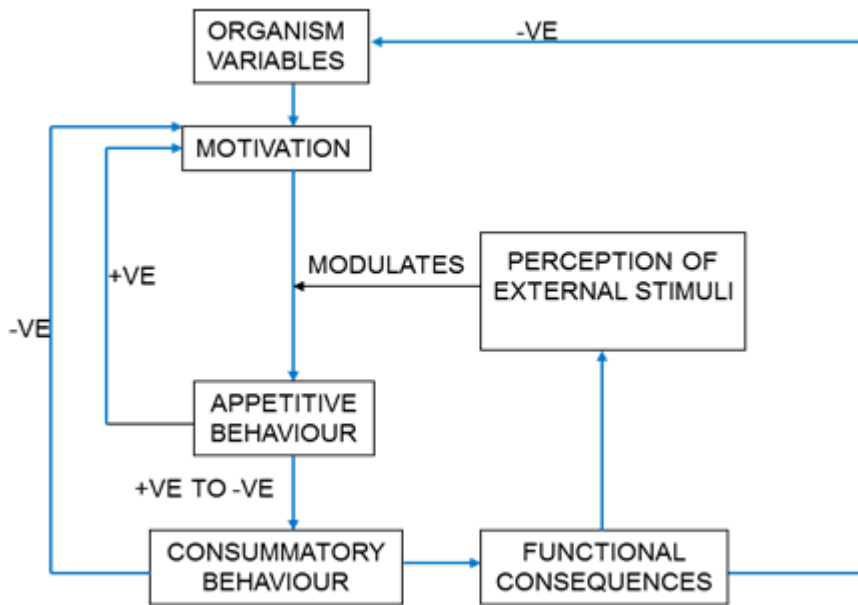


Figure 1. The Hughes and Duncan (1988) Model of Behavioural Motivation

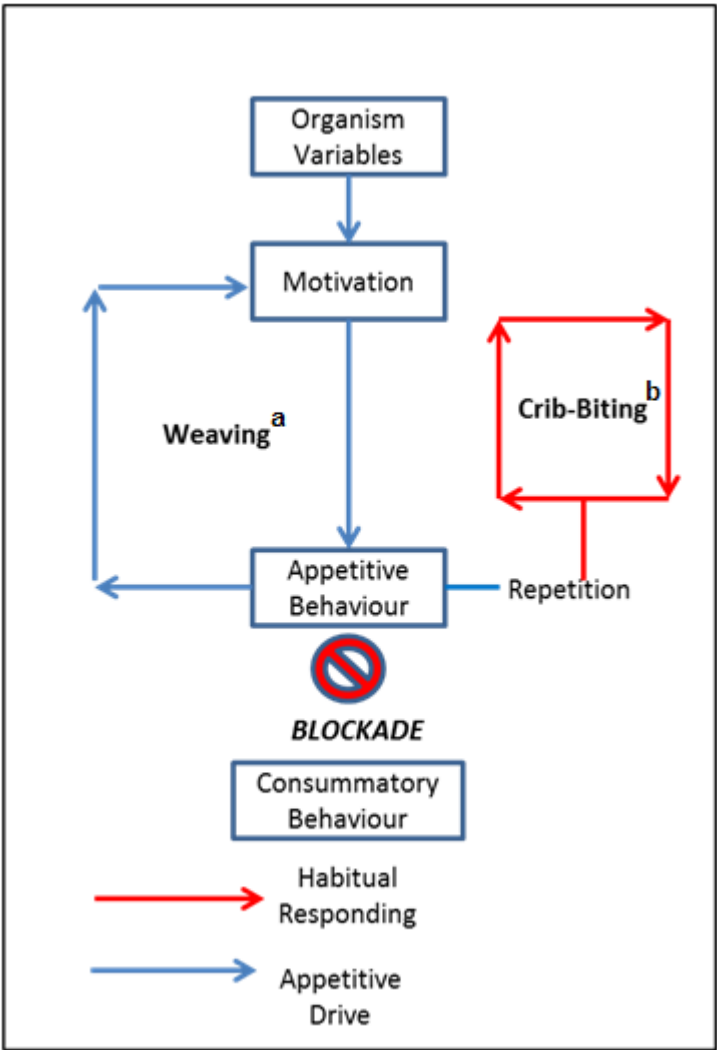


Figure 2. The motivational basis of locomotor (a) and oral (b) stereotypy in the horse
